

LEWISTON TRANSIT PROJECT LIST – STIMULUS 2

Guidance was given to assume the same funding level under Stimulus 2 as was received in ARRA funds. Lewiston received \$547,000 in Section 5307 ARRA funds.

The City of Lewiston has submitted the following projects for Stimulus 2 funding:

- 2 buses \$100,000
- Bus parking, land acquisition 60,000
Transit would only pay a proportionate share of the cost to acquire a lot downtown based on the amount of the lot they will be using. Other city funds would be used for the balance.
- Bus parking security 60,000
Fencing and or cameras.
- Community Center stop reconfiguration 100,000
Reconfiguration of the south side of the Community Center parking lot to allow a portion to be completely segregated for exclusive bus and pedestrian use. Potential work includes cutting in two new curb cuts on "G" and Lincoln, relocation of curbing, landscaping to widen the existing travel lane, placement of a semi enclosed and heated passenger waiting shelter of approximately 300-500 square feet, conversion of some parking lot to landscaping with irrigation. A principal benefit of the work is to eliminate a point of congestion at the front of the community center by separating bus traffic from vehicles and pedestrians entering the community center. Buses can stage without blocking the front doors and parking stalls. The seasonally heated shelter and open seating areas will allow passengers to wait in comfort.
- WC accessible relief van 45,000
- Drive cameras for buses 20,000
- Bus stop improvements 106,000
(shelters, ADA access, solar powered lights)
- Operating 54,000
